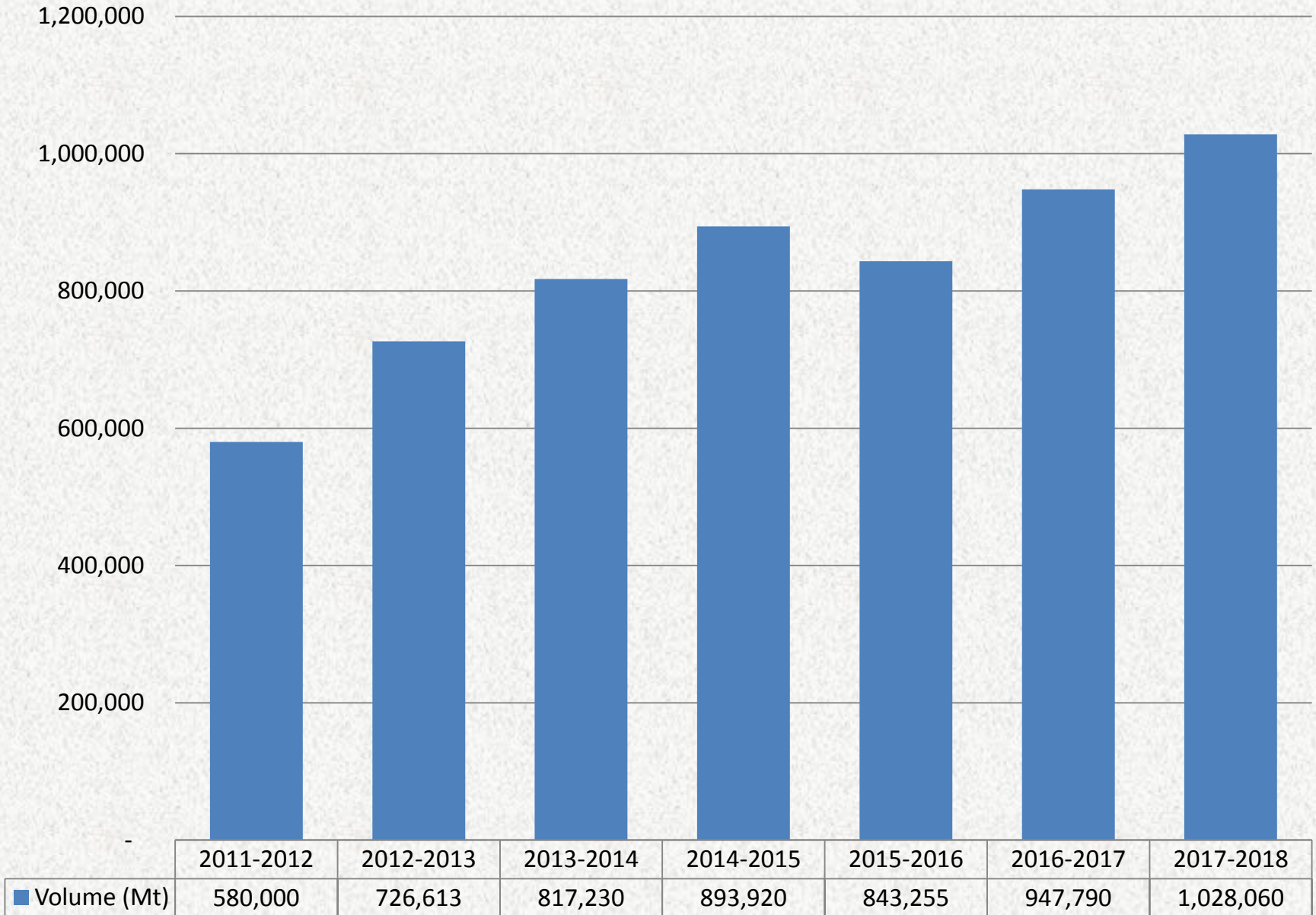

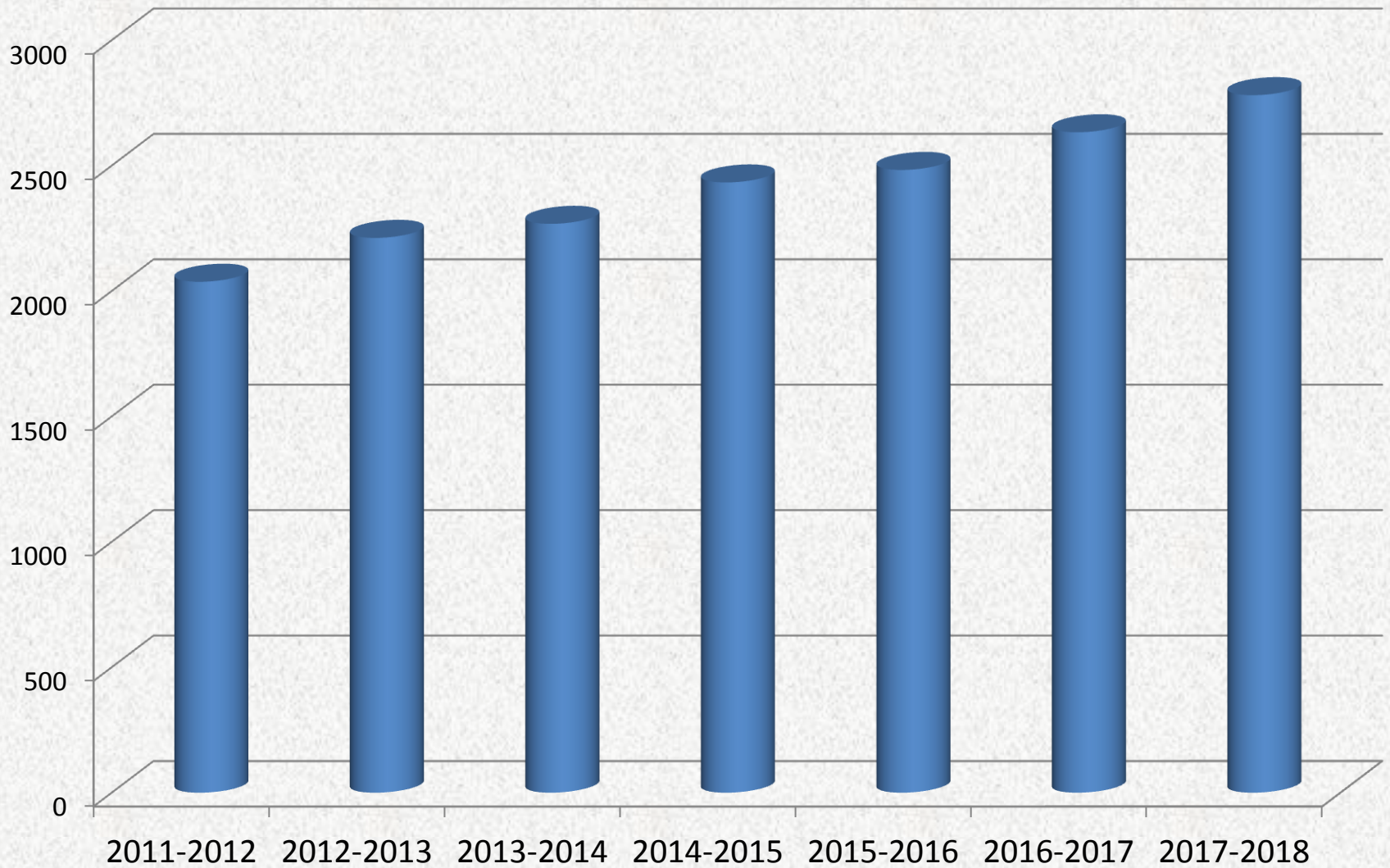

Spice Export Data

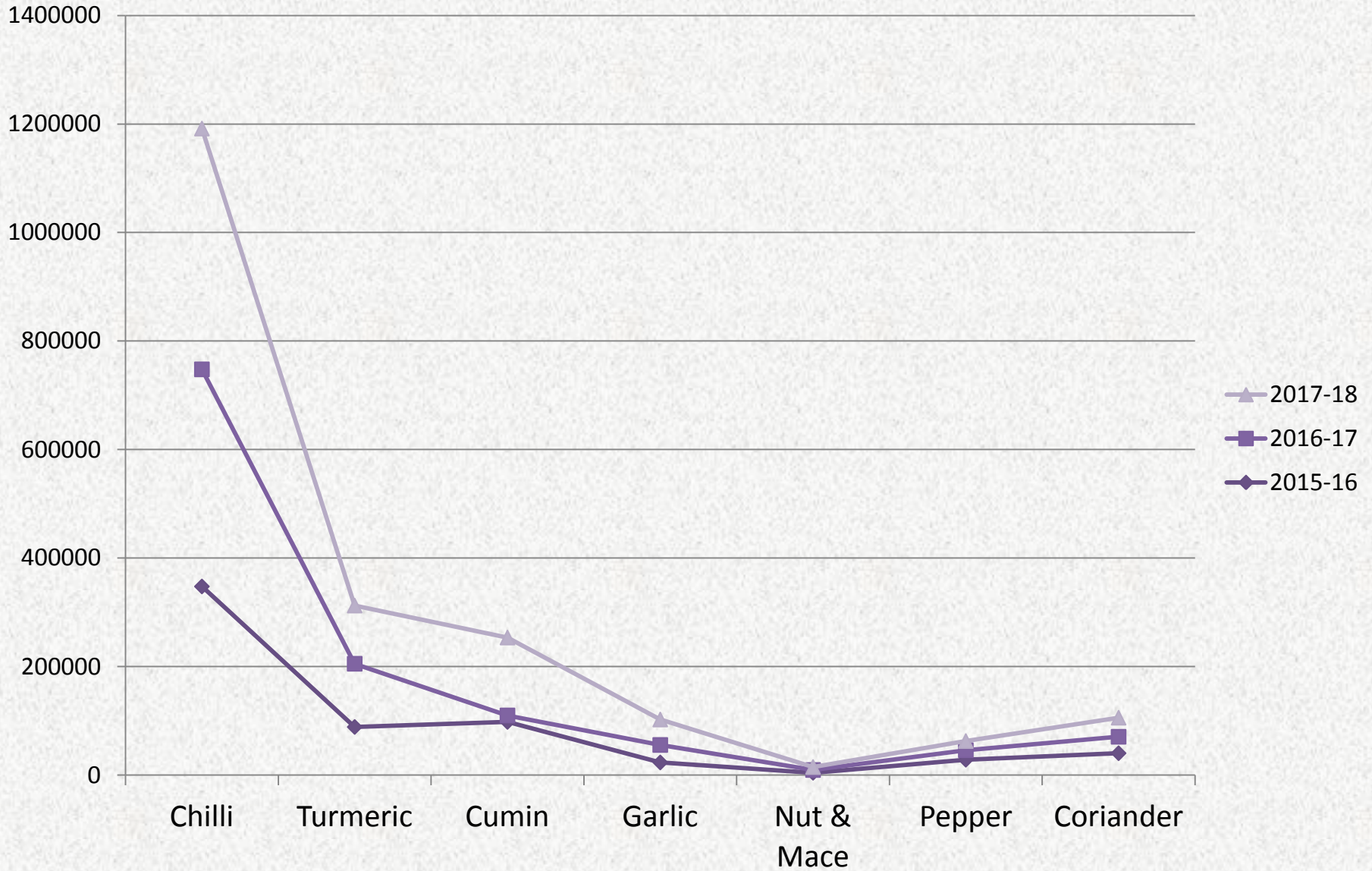


Spice Export Data

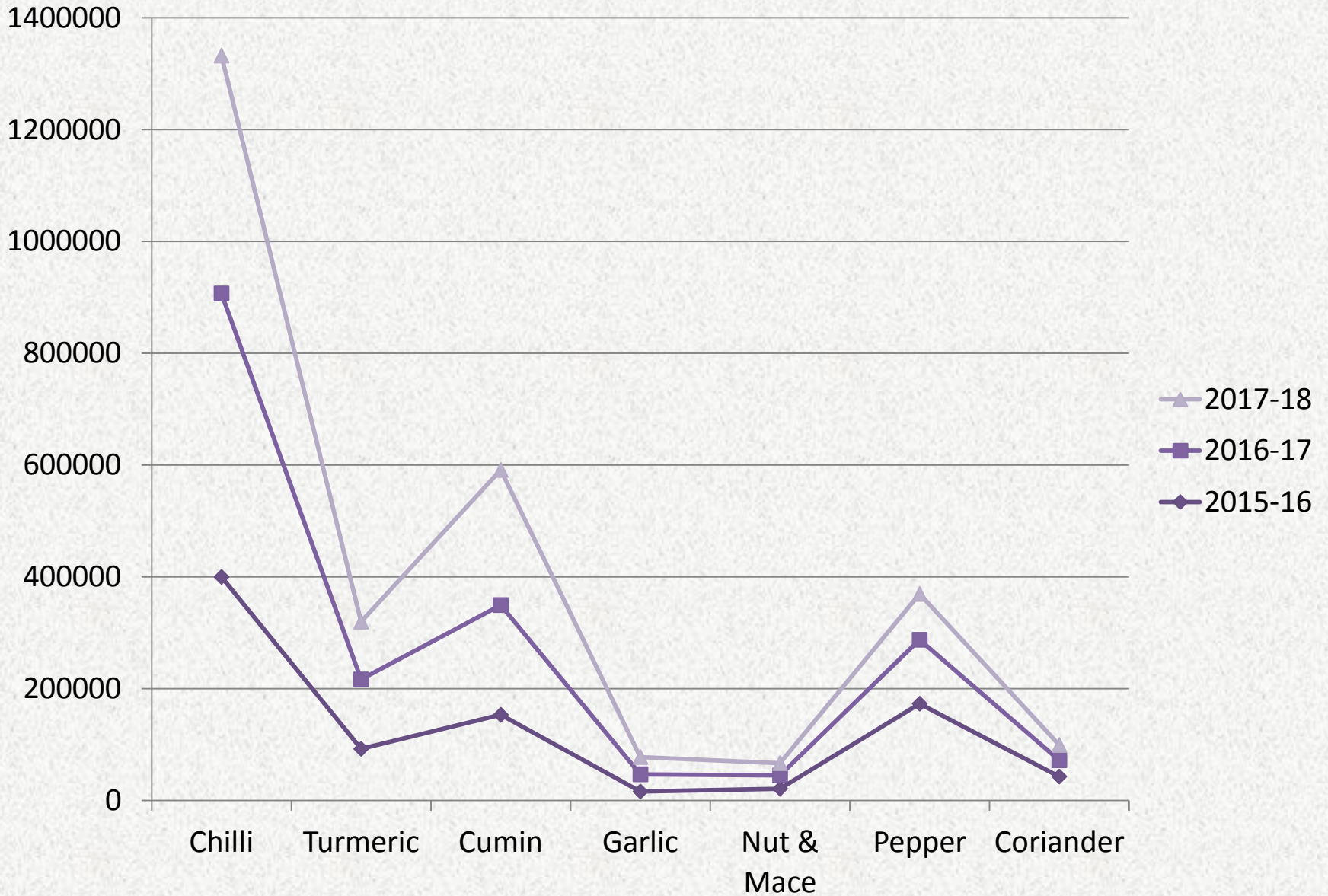
Value (\$ Mln)
